On June 23, 2015 the EIC and guests toured 304 North Main Street and went to Octane for lunch. There were 19 in attendance. January of 2015 Transatlantic President Kevin Holdmann and his wife Lenae Weichel purchased the building at 304 North Main Street and are in the process of doing a \$5 million historic renovation of this 55,000 square foot building next to the Coronado Theatre. Lenae provided us with a tour of the building. She provided interesting history and insight into what it takes to renovate a building like this with an environmental protection focus. They have removed all asbestos and torn down walls and duct work. They are literally in the throes of renovation. They will have room for other companies or agencies that may want to set up home at 304 North Main Street. LWVGR Annual Meeting 2015


The League of Women Voters Greater Rockford held its annual meeting at Forest Hills Country Club on Saturday, June 13, 2015. The keynote speaker was Hon. Janet Holmgren.

Judge Janet Holmgren currently is the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile and Problem-solving Courts Divisions of the 17th Judicial Circuit Court, which includes Winnebago and Boone Counties. Judge Holmgren's court assignment includes presiding over the Adult Drug Court, the Therapeutic Intervention Program (TIP) Mental Health Court, Veteran's Court, Family Drug Court, which is a program for substance abusing parents in abuse and neglect court, Youth Recovery Court, which is the only juvenile mental health court in Illinois, and all juvenile court proceedings in Boone County.

The League business meeting included the election of officers and committee reports were presented. Slated officers for 2015-2016 elected were: Claire McInytre, President, Christine Hilltrop, Vice President, Martha Pippitt, Treasurer, Jo Minor, Secretary.

Judge Holmgren spoke on the history of usually punitive solutions for the mentally ill and the development of Problem Solving Courts in Winnebago County such as the Winnebago County Adult Drug Court in1996; Therapeutic Intervention Program (TIP) Court in 2005; Family Drug Court in 2009; Veteran's Court in 2012; and Youth Recovery Court in 2012.
