Health Issues Committee reports interesting news from Chicago Newspaper! Voters in Northwest Chicago community passed a Mental Health initiative by a 74% majority. They were the first in Illinois to consider a new binding referendum to fund services to expand mental health services in the North River community. They had the opportunity to tax themselves, through property tax, to pay for some free mental health services that the government has chipped away. The measure's supporters say they hope other neighborhoods follow suit with their own ballot-based solutions.

The need for education on Mental Health Issues and the Affordable Care Act has been brought to the public's attention by the media. It is time for the LWV health committee to set our priorities and be the catalyst for change.
